

Adam and Matt also brought some great auction items from the Museum. Additionally, Corvette Racing and Doug Fehan, through the Museum, provided some fantastic auction items. Most notable were Doug's credentials and satchel from the 24 Hours of Le Mans which sold for \$1,000.00 and the damaged fascia from one of the C7R race cars that fetched \$1,050.00.

A guitar, obtained through the Museum, was from NCM Board Member Lon Helton, who is also on the Board of the Country Music Hall of Fame and is an 8 time winner of the CMA Broadcast Personality of the Year. That guitar was autographed by ten famous musicians, including Jason Aldean, Luke Bryan, Toby Keith, Keith Urban, Carrie Underwood and more. It sold for a very nice \$2,100.

Because of his involvement with the NCM and his appreciation of LSCC's support of the Museum, Doug Fehan, Program Manager of Corvette Racing, gave his time to come to the Classic as our guest speaker. He spent all day Saturday visiting with Corvette owners at the car show. Then Saturday night he spoke at the awards banquet. He was interesting, educating, and funny. I'll bet you will agree that he was the best speaker in a long time.

Track Time on the LSCC Club Trip to the NCM

I have received track surveys back from about half of the people attending the club trip. Please check your email, fill out and return your short profile to me if you haven't already; I need this information to make sure we have enough instructor help for everyone at the track. Don't worry about having prior track experience; this is not a competitive event and there will be NO WHEEL TO WHEEL RACING! Use this time to learn proper performance driving at a safe moderate speed.....with NO oncoming traffic or LEO's to worry about.

Q&A

Track Insurance:

I have had a couple people ask me about track insurance; YES it is available but in my opinion it's expensive and unnecessary. *As long as you are self-disciplined and stick to the 7/10's rule* (drive 70% of *your ability*, MAX), you will not have any problems. Overtaking slower cars will only happen during Day 2 in open track groups. Passing will be done under very strict rules and only in designated "Passing Zones" (long straight-aways).

Loaner Helmets:

Some of you will need to borrow a Brain Bucket for the track. First of all, let me make it clear that you do not need a helmet for the "TOURING GROUP" (lead and follow) on Day 2. ALL other run groups will require a helmet. You have two choices; you may sign out a club helmet at the June club meeting for FREE or rent one from the museum at the track (limited supply) for \$10. PLEASE reserve all club helmets with me PRIOR to the June meeting.

Passengers:

Yes, you may have passengers in the "TOURING GROUP ONLY"; no helmets required.

Rag Tops:

Yes, you may participate with your convertible; you will be limited to Track-X on Day 1 and Touring laps on Day 2......You WILL NOT be permitted to participate in any of the open track groups unless your car is equipped with an SCCA approved Roll Bar.

Here's a recap of the track time itinerary;

Day 1; Most of the day will consist of something like Auto-X but not nearly as complicated. It's called "Track-

X"; you will drive at your own speed over most of the course following cones to position you on the proper track line and gates to slow you down to a safe speed. Click "HERE" for an idea of what Track-X is all about. Depending on the overall number of people wanting to participate in track driving, we may divide up into two groups; while one group is on the track, the other will have classroom time and then we will rotate groups every hour or so.

Day 2; This is the day all of you hot shoes are waiting for! We will divide into groups as per experience level and run the full track without the Track-X cones. Instructors will be riding with the beginners until Soloed or moved up into the intermediate group. All other drivers (intermediate and advance) will have a check ride with an instructor before being signed off as Solo.

<u>Here's a video</u> of the full track at "Parade" lap speed (much slower than touring speed), be sure to kill the sound so you don't have to listen to Terri and me!.

If you are thinking of participating in this club event and have yet to sign up, please do so right now; we need an accurate count to make this come off without a hitch.

Autocross

The LSCC autocross will be held on the third Saturday of each month beginning in March and ending in November.

We will be holding our events at Brookhaven College. Brookhaven is located at 3939 Valley View Lane (Valley View Lane and Alpha Road) in Farmers Branch. We will be racing on parking lot P2. P2 is concrete rather than asphalt. This is the link of the Brookhaven campus map.

Setup will begin at 8:30 am. For those helping with set up, be there at 8:30 am. The more help we have the quicker we get to start. Drivers should be there no later than 9:00 am to register and sign waivers. We begin racing at 9:30 am.

The fee to drive is \$15 per car. All drivers and passengers must be members of LSCC. Drivers and passengers must wear a helmet when on the course. Non-members must remain in a designated spectator area and may not enter the pits when anyone is on the course.

Dates for the autocross in 2015 are: June 20, July18 (if temperature permits), August 15 (if temperature permits), September 19, October 17 and November 21 (rain date).

26th Annual Classic Wrap-Up

Our 26th Annual Classic is over and in spite of the sketchy weather all events were held with only a few minor delays or inconvenience. The overall attendance was down a bit from last year's 25th Anniversary but that was expected since 2014 was such a milestone event and our weather threatened most of the week this year. We welcomed our old friends who always support us and met many new people who attended their 1st Classic. We had participants & guests from 15 states, Michigan, Wisconsin and Virginia the farthest, plus Australia and the Netherlands.

We had over 750 participants included in over 450 registrations for the Classic. Our Friday Kick Up Your Heels Cruise included 220 Corvettes in a long caravan that stretched several miles from TMS to Circle R Ranch in Flower Mound under the guidance of 14 Denton County law enforcement officers who controlled every intersection assuring us a continuous, smooth and safe cruise through the country.

The Saturday Car Show totaled 260 cars in both Member & Non-Member Judged and Show N' Shine categories. Our Saturday Awards Dinner was well attended and everyone enjoyed our guest speaker, Doug Fehan, from Corvette Racing. We welcomed back Weldon Floyd, auctioneer extraordinaire, who not only entertained us but also helped us raise over \$15,500.00 for our charities at the Live Auction. We raised over \$22,250.00 with both the Live and Silent Auctions, down about 14% from 2014, but still a nice amount for our combined charities.

Sunday Track Day turned out to be the best day of the entire 3-day Classic. The early morning storms quickly turned to clear blue skies and the limited number of stalwarts hung in there and enjoyed a great track day with multiple runs on both the Oval and Road Course as the lines were extremely short. We had 17 participants sign-up for the activities on site, several just taking a chance that we were open and we may have actually recruited 2 new members for our efforts.

I want to thank all who participated; especially all our coordinators and volunteers who help make this event happen, you did a fantastic job. See you May 20 – 22, 2016!
