Founded in 1982, the Club now has over 1,000 members – each with his/her own story to tell of how they found that perfect "Vette." Based in the Dallas – Fort Worth Metroplex, it offers just about any activity an owner of "America's Sports Car" could want: Road Trips, Day Trips, Open Road Racing, DragRacing, Autocross, NCRS (National Corvette Restorers Society), Car Shows, Displays and Parades, the Lone Star Corvette Classic, Club Meetings, and most of all, fun times with good friends.

Road Trips – Want to explore the wide open road? The Club takes at least one significant road trip each year, usually in conjunction with a Corvette event. A large group recently returned from a caravan to Eureka Springs, Arkansas, winning the club participation event at the show. Past trips have taken us to the Upper Pennisula of Michigan, the Barrett Jackson Auction in Scottsdale, Arizona, the National Corvette Museum's 15th Anniversary Caravan to Bowling Green, Kentucky, and many more.

Day Trips – Want to enjoy North Texas? Just about every month finds a group of us headed somewhere in our Corvettes for a day of fun on the road. It might be for a tour of some local wineries, a trip to the Historic Fort Worth Stockyards for a cattle drive and BBQ, a car show being held by another Corvette club, a tour of members' garages, or just a drive in the country to enjoy our cars and each other's company.

Open Road Racing – Like to go fast in your Vette? Many Club members participate in Open Road Racing at events held in Big Bend, Texas and Arnold, Nebraska. In addition, several driving schools are offered in the DFW area where you can go to hone your driving skills. For more information, just"click" on "<u>Open Road Racing</u>".

Drag Racing – Want to "go fast"? Join the club Drag Racers. They compete at tracks around the Metroplexfor trophies and bragging rights. Many members –both ladies and men – race cars (pickups too) in addition to Corvettes. No experience is required. For more information, just "click" on "<u>Drag Racing</u>".

Autocross – Want to sharpen your driving skills? Try autocross! An autocross is a timed competition where drivers navigate, one at a time, through a temporary course marked by traffic cones, usually in a parking lot. Autocross places more emphasis on car handling and driving skill than on sheer horsepower. For more information, just "click" on "Autocross".

NCRS – Want your older model corvette to be an accurate icon? Many Club members also belong to the NCRS – National Corvette Restorers Society. If you are into originality and the preservation of the Corvette as an icon, you will find many in the Club that share your passion. For more information, just "click" on "<u>NCRS</u>".

Car Shows – Love showing your Vette off or having it judged? On almost any weekend (except for a few in the winter), at least one group from the Club will be headed to either a local or an out-of-town car show. We usually caravan to the out-of-town shows as a group and use the trip as a good excuse to socialize and dine out together. The Club sponsors a group of members each year in the Dallas Autorama. On the first Saturday of each month, you'll find a bunch of us at Cars & Coffee in Plano, "kicking tires" and telling tall tales about our cars.

Displays and Parades – Looking to share the Corvetter spirit? Every year we man a display of our cars in the Dallas New Car Show at the Convention Center. We also take a large contingent of Vettes to the State Fair of Texas. We've been asked in the past to drive Indy Car drivers around the Texas Motor Speedway's oval before races. Christmas finds us backing up the bikers in the Great Texas Toy Run that benefits thousands of needy children in the area. The Dallas Veterans' Day Parade has come to rely on the Club to provide cars and drivers for over 100 WWII Veterans each year. Ask any Club member who has participated and you will be told what an honor it is.

Lone Star Corvette Classic – In May of each year, the premier Corvette event in Texas is held at the Texas Motor Speedway by the Club. During its three day run, the "Classic" attracts hundreds of Corvettes and Corvette Club members from across the US and Canada. In addition, Corvette enthusiasts from around the area attend the event to take advantage of many different activities, including judged and Show N Shine indoor car shows, a variety of automotive vendors, good food, and exciting track events held on the Texas Motor Speedway's oval and road course. 100% of the net proceeds from the Classic go to support the Club's two main charities, The National Corvette Museum and Speedway Children's Charities, and a third charity chosen from several candidates each year by Club members.

Club Meetings – We want you! The Club meets on the second Saturday of each month at various locations around the Metroplex. We would love to have you come to a meeting and "check us out." I'd like to encourage you to further explore our website. A glimpse at the Club's Event Calendar will give you a good overview of just how active and diverse our Club is. NCM News

A lot has happened in the last month at the NCM and more is happening as we go into October.

NCM 24th Anniversary - 2018

Labor Day weekend the Museum celebrated its 24th Anniversary and over 20 people from LSCC were there.

The NCM Ambassador luncheon was one of the first events as the Anniversary Celebration opened on Thursday. Thanks to LSCC members' and club support of the Museum, Johnny and Edie Downs received the Master Ambassador award for the 14th consecutive year.

During the Ambassador luncheon, Stephanie Morrill, Membership Director, revealed current NCM membership numbers. The total number of active members is 33,700. Of those, 5,933 are Lifetime.

Most LSCC members who made this trip were present at the Membership meeting on Thursday afternoon when 2018 Classic Officer Rick Herrick presented a Texas size check for \$9,600.00 to the NCM. The check was accepted by Board Chairman Lon Helton, an LSCC member, and Director Wendell Strode.

The donation is going to be used to acquire and display more cars of great significance in the history of Corvette. I believe the dollar amount is the largest by a club this year.

Thursday evening, the Museum hosted a dinner, inviting all Lifetime members, giving them a preview introduction to the Corvette Hall of Fame inductees. At least 15 LSCC members were in attendance.

Each day of the celebration was filled with demonstrations, seminars, tours and more. The Corvette Hall of Fame Friday evening was a not-to-miss event and most LSCC members attended. Racers Burt and John Greenwood, former Corvette Chief Engineer Tom Wallace and Enthusiast Mike Yager, founder of Mid America Motorworks were inducted. Excellent video introductions were followed by presentations.

It seemed that if there was a presentation, LSCC was there. Saturday, as the celebration wound down, 10/15/20/25 year members were recognized. LSCC's David Orrick received his 10-year pin. Congratulations to him!

This report on the 24th Anniversary would not be complete without recognizing the LSCC members who

volunteered their time during the celebration. I am going from memory, so at the risk of leaving someone out, at least one member of the following families gave their time to the NCM – Nester, Johnson, Dobbins, Orrick, Downs, Helton, Mariano, Weidemier.

NCM 25th Anniversary & Caravan 2019

It is important to do the LSCC registration first. When you do this, you will receive information from Curt Troster and Johnny Downs that will help you when you register with the NCM. You will also receive hotel information.

Anyone who registered for the Caravan with LSCC before September 10 has been sent the Caravan and hotel information.

The NCRS Texas Chapter was founded by local members of the National Corvette Restorers Society. Our mission is to promote the restoration, preservation, history and enjoyment of the Chevrolet Corvette. Membership in the Texas Chapter is available to all current members of the NCRS national organization. Las Vegas, NV - According to Google -- 1218 miles from Dallas, TX. Site of the NCRS 2018 National Convention in mid July held at the South Point Hotel and Resort, an all indoor facility to accommodate all the Corvettes plus the other requirements necessary such as several restaurants to choose from. Corvettes registered numbered 118 for judging or display and pursuing 116 various awards. Top Flight awards came in at thirty-three, with two 2nd Flight awards, and 16 Duntov award winners. This National event was hosted by the Southern Arizona Chapter.

To my knowledge, only one LSCC member made the trek, a test of endurance in itself, to the NCRS National event. Lee Brumit survived the distance and the heat and entered his 1995 Corvette for Flight judging and was awarded a Top Flight Certificate for his efforts. Congratulations to Lee.

All judging was conducted inside the facility, which avoided the heat factor, except for operations check. The decision was made to do this at 5 A.M. in the morning, in order to get owners and cars inside as quickly as possible. It is difficult to perform a cold start test when temperatures are 90 degrees and rising.

In attendance as special guests were former Corvette Chief Engineers Dave McClellan and Dave Hill.

NCRS Chapter Top Flight Awards were presented - one of which again went to the Texas NCRS Chapter along with 34 other NCRS chapters from around the country.

The Texas Road Tour from DFW to Las Vegas, headed up by Ken Robb, developed with an interesting side note. A particular couple, when upon arriving in Las Vegas, intended to visit a drive - through wedding chapel. As the other members became aware of this, Gary Chesnut arranged for the ceremony to happen at the convention - and so it did!! Michael and Pru are the happy couple - Congratulations to them.
