The Lone Star Corvette Club is dedicated to the Corvette lifestyle and the people that own them.

Our Club slogan says it all:

Founded in 1982, the Club now has over 1,000 members – each with his/her own story to tell of how they found that perfect “Vette.” Based in the Dallas – Fort Worth Metroplex, it offers just about any activity an owner of “America’s Sports Car” could want: Road Trips, Day Trips, Open Road Racing, Drag Racing, Autocross, NCRS (National Corvette Restorers Society), Car Shows, Displays and Parades, the Lone Star Corvette Classic, Club Meetings, and most of all, fun times with good friends.

Road Trips – Want to explore the wide open road? The Club takes at least one significant road trip each year, usually in conjunction with a Corvette event. A large group recently returned from a caravan to Eureka Springs, Arkansas, winning the club participation event at the show. Past trips have taken us to the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, the Barrett Jackson Auction in Scottsdale, Arizona, the National Corvette Museum’s 15th Anniversary Caravan to Bowling Green, Kentucky, and many more.

Day Trips – Want to enjoy North Texas? Just about every month finds a group of us headed somewhere in our Corvettes for a day of fun on the road. It might be for a tour of some local wineries, a trip to the Historic Fort Worth Stockyards for a cattle drive and BBQ, a car show being held by another Corvette club, a tour of members’ garages, or just a drive in the country to enjoy our cars and each other’s company.

Open Road Racing – Like to go fast in your Vette? Many Club members participate in Open Road Racing at events held in Big Bend, Texas and Arnold, Nebraska. In addition, several driving schools are offered in the DFW area where you can go to hone your driving skills. For more information, just “click” on [“Open Road Racing”](#).

Drag Racing – Want to “go fast”? Join the club Drag Racers. They compete at tracks around the Metroplex for trophies and bragging rights. Many members – both ladies and men – race cars (pickups too) in addition to Corvettes. No experience is required. For more information, just “click” on [“Drag Racing”](#).

Autocross – Want to sharpen your driving skills? Try autocross! An autocross is a timed competition where drivers navigate, one at a time, through a temporary course marked by traffic cones, usually in a parking lot. Autocross places more emphasis on car handling and driving skill than on sheer horsepower. For more information, just “click” on [“Autocross”](#).

NCRS – Want your older model corvette to be an accurate icon? Many Club members also belong to the NCRS – National Corvette Restorers Society. If you are into originality and the preservation of the Corvette as an icon, you will find many in the Club that share your passion. For more information, just “click” on [“NCRS”](#).

Car Shows – Love showing your Vette off or having it judged? On almost any weekend (except for a few in the winter), at least one group from the Club will be headed to either a local or an out-of-town car show. We usually caravan to the out-of-town shows as a group and use the trip as a good excuse to socialize and dine out together. The Club sponsors a group of members each year in Dallas Autorama.

Displays and Parades – Looking to share the Corvetter spirit? Every year we man a display of our cars in the Dallas New Car Show at the Convention Center. We also take a large contingent of Vettes to the State Fair of Texas. We’ve been asked in the past to drive Indy Car drivers around the Texas Motor Speedway’s oval before races. Christmas finds us backing up the bikers in the Great Texas Toy Run that benefits thousands of needy children in the area. The Dallas Veterans’ Day Parade has come to rely on the Club to provide cars and drivers for over 100 WWII Veterans each year. Ask any Club member who has participated and you will be told what an honor it is.

Lone Star Corvette Classic – In May of each year, the premier Corvette event in Texas is held at the Texas Motor Speedway by the Club. During its three day run, the “Classic” attracts hundreds of Corvettes and Corvette Club members from across the US and Canada. In addition, Corvette enthusiasts from around the area attend the event to take advantage of many different activities, including judged and Show N Shine indoor car shows, a variety of automotive vendors, good food, and exciting track events held on the Texas Motor Speedway’s oval and road course. 100% of the net proceeds from the Classic go to support the Club’s two main charities, The National Corvette Museum and Speedway Children’s Charities, and a third charity chosen from several candidates each year by Club members.

Club Meetings – We want you! The Club meets on the second Saturday of each month at various locations around the Metroplex. We would love to have you come to a meeting and “check us out.”

To date 2 Classic Road Rallies have been held, generating \$3,200.00 for our Charities. Several additional rallies are being planned for Sep. and Oct., so keep checking the Club website and look for email updates. Our hope is that these outings continue to be supported by our members; our goal is to not only raise some charity funds, but also provide an opportunity to drive our Vettes in some scenic areas of the Metroplex.

## NCM News

Due to COVID-19 related cancellations and closings it has been difficult to find NCM news to report and this month is no exception.

NCM Anniversary Celebration

Unless the cancellation monster strikes again, some LSCC members will be making history the first week of September. We will attend our first public Corvette event of 2020. The NCM Anniversary Celebration is still on for September 2 - 5.

The Winner's Circle dinner will be held on September 2nd. LSCC and 62 of its members will be recognized for their contribution to the Museum. LSCC has chosen this event to make the presentation of a \$10,000 check to the NCM. This donation comes from unspent funds raised for the 2020 Classic and monies raised from LSCC's ongoing monthly road rallies. The check is earmarked for XP-987 sponsorship.

Regarding our club members' sponsorship of the XP-987 two-rotor Corvette, the ceremony recognizing LSCC members for this accomplishment has, once again, been postponed. In consultation with the NCM, it was decided to reschedule the ceremony to the Bash next April. Hopes are that more club members will be able to attend at that time.

The Corvette Hall of Fame scheduled for the Anniversary event, has been postponed to the Bash. Also, plant tours have not begun, but should be available next spring. Now is not too soon to plan for our caravan to the Bash, April 21-24, 2021.

MiM - One Lap of Kentucky

If you are like we are and starved for some Corvette fun, the NCM has a solution. They have rolled out their very popular One Lap of Kentucky tours for this fall.

2020 will be the 11<sup>th</sup> year of the Kentucky 1 Lap Tour, part of the Museum in Motion program. It is unique in that it is a partnership between the NCM and the Kentucky State Police. Together they raise funds for the NCM and Trooper Island, a non-profit camp for under privileged children.

Each year the tour explores a different section of Kentucky. As always, it will be led by a Kentucky State Trooper in a marked state police Corvette.

These are strange times. Many Corvette events have been cancelled. There is great concern about participation in future events. Because of that, please see the letter below about the Roundup.

LSCC Friends,

As of now, WCCA is moving forward with plans to host the NTCR this September 18-19, 2020.

The number of pre-registrations we receive will determine whether or not we will cancel this year's event.

A final decision will be made on August 1, 2020.



## LSCC Officer Duties

2. Coordinate car shows – in town and out of town – that involve certification judging by sanctioning organizations like NCRS. In the event the nature of the event is ambiguous, the Club President shall make the decision whether responsibility of the event is Recreational or Competitive.
3. Coordinate participation in NCRTS activities.
4. Assure that Club insurance requirements are met for each event.

- The duties of the **Recreational Events Officer** will include, but not be limited to:

1. Coordinate road trips, including trips to car shows with a primary emphasis of fund raising and/or recreation. In the event the nature of the event is ambiguous, the Club President shall make the decision whether responsibility of the event is Recreational or Competitive.
2. Coordinate car displays.
3. Coordinate dinner cruises.
4. Coordinate swap meets, detail days, shade tree events, etc.
5. Ensure that Club insurance requirements are met for Club sanctioned events that meet coverage criteria as outlined by the Club's insurance carrier. This

includes ensuring that event coordinators complete the required Independent Club Event Liability (ICEL) forms and collect the required, current, properly formatted, and signed waivers from event participants. The Recreational Events Officer will submit the completed ICEL to the insurance agent and ensure that all documents are delivered to the Recording Secretary for archival.

- The duties of the **Recording Secretary** will include, but not be limited to:

1. Keep the minutes of the business and Board of Directors meetings and will submit it to the Board of Directors and the business meeting minutes to the newsletter editor.
2. Maintain all written communications for the club.
3. In his/her absence, the recording secretary will choose a member in good standing of the club to represent them and fulfill the duties and obligations of the recording secretary.
4. Maintain the club Bylaws.

- The duties of the **Membership Officer** will include, but not be limited to:

1. Process and maintain all applications for membership.
2. Keep an updated membership list with all member information and will provide it to all officers as needed. This information will be used for club business only.

# Corvette Racing C8.R Makes it 3 in a Row!

ELKHART LAKE, Wis. (Aug. 2, 2020) – Corvette Racing took its second consecutive 1-2 finish in the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship's GT Le Mans (GTLM class) following a chaotic finish Sunday at Road America. Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor won for the second time in their No. 3 Mobil 1/SiriusXM Chevrolet Corvette C8.R following a late-race pass in torrential rain.




